### BUSTING THE WELFARE-TO-WORK MYTH

### Framing the message:

- Enrollees are already workers
- MFIP is Workforce Development for low-income workers
- MFIP enrollees are active
- Investing in striving families makes sense for employers and the economy
- The pool of workers in MFIP could help close the skills gap



## 2014 LEGISLATIVE AGENDA

### MFIP Workforce Education Bill

- Allows the freedom to access Adult Basic Education
- Removes roadblocks to post-secondary education
- Removes outdated barriers that limit self-sufficiency

Currently, the bill language is in both the House and the Senate supplemental appropriations bills. A conference committee is still working on crafting the final bill.



## WHAT'S NEXT?

Prosperity for All is a multi-year campaign to make MFIP the best program it can be for low-wage workers in Minnesota. Partners and organizations will work together to craft legislation for 2015 and beyond.

With new access to training and education plus robust supports for success, workers enrolled in MFIP will meet the needs of the 21st century employer.
